FACILITATORS

Carol Browning serves as Liturgy and Music Coordinator at Padre Serra Parish in Camarillo, California, and has been active in music ministry for almost twenty years. A member of the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers), Carol is a liturgical composer and an independently published inspirational songwriter.

Joe Simmons has been inspiring cantors and lectors through formation workshops all over the United States for many years. His rich and varied background in music has led him to serve as the Principal Cantor at the Church of St. John the Baptist in New York City, as a bilingual (English/Spanish) clinician and convention presenter for the National Association of Pastoral Musicians, a concert artist, and a former vocal performance faculty member at New York University. Simmons holds a Master's degree in music performance and a Professional Certificate in Life Coaching from New York University. He is also a graduate of the Contemplative Group Leaders program of the Shalem Institute for Spiritual Formation.

• **What is St. Cecilia Sing?**

This is the second year pastoral musicians in the Archdiocese of Seattle will celebrate this event. *St. Cecilia Sing* is a gathering to rejoice in the gift to the church of pastoral musicians. On a weekend near the *Memorial of St. Cecilia*—singers throughout the United States are gathering for concerts, retreats, and other musical events. They gather to be enriched in their ministry and experience the joy of liturgical music.

• **How is the Local Church Celebrating?**

This year the musicians of the Archdiocese of Seattle are gathering at Holy Rosary, Edmonds. Participants will be led by Joe Simmons and Carol Browning to explore music for the whole assembly. They will introduce newly produced resources that provide three songs—entrance, responsorial, and communion—for each Sunday and Solemnity of all three cycles of the liturgical year, as well as songs for sacramental celebrations and funerals. The songs are easy to learn, flexible and can be sung with or without instruments. At the end of the day, all participants are invited to celebrate the Eucharistic liturgy utilizing the music experienced during the day.

• **Who is this day for?**

Ideally, any person involved in music at the parish. Most especially, choir members and musical leaders will find this day to be very helpful and *FUN!* The facilitators will lead participants through specific techniques that will assist musicians in their work of serving the Body of Christ.


